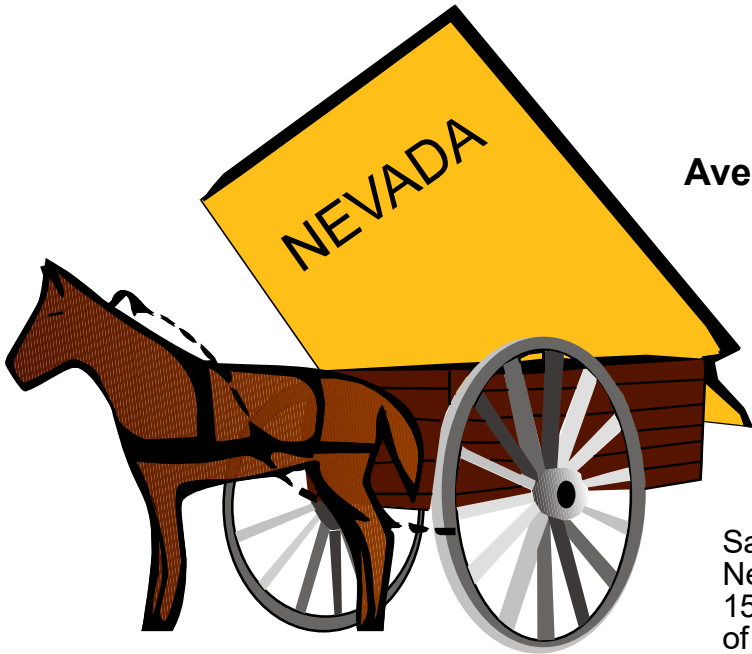


Exodus in Perspective

Imagine moving the entire population of Nevada including Las Vegas, Reno, Carson City, and Lake Tahoe. That is approximately the same number of people that left Egypt during the Exodus. Exodus 12:37 and Numbers 2:32 states the number at over 600,000 males, 20 years and older. Since this number is merely the older males and excludes the Levites, the total number of persons most likely exceeded two million. According to the U.S. Census Bureau the entire population of Nevada in 2001 was slightly over 2,100,000.

Average American Food Consumption per Year

- Meat - 190 Pounds
- Dairy Products - 580 Pounds
- Fruits and Vegetables - 711 Pounds
- Flour and Cereal Products - 200 Pounds
- Carbonated Soft Drinks - 53 Gallons
- Coffee - 23.5 Gallons
