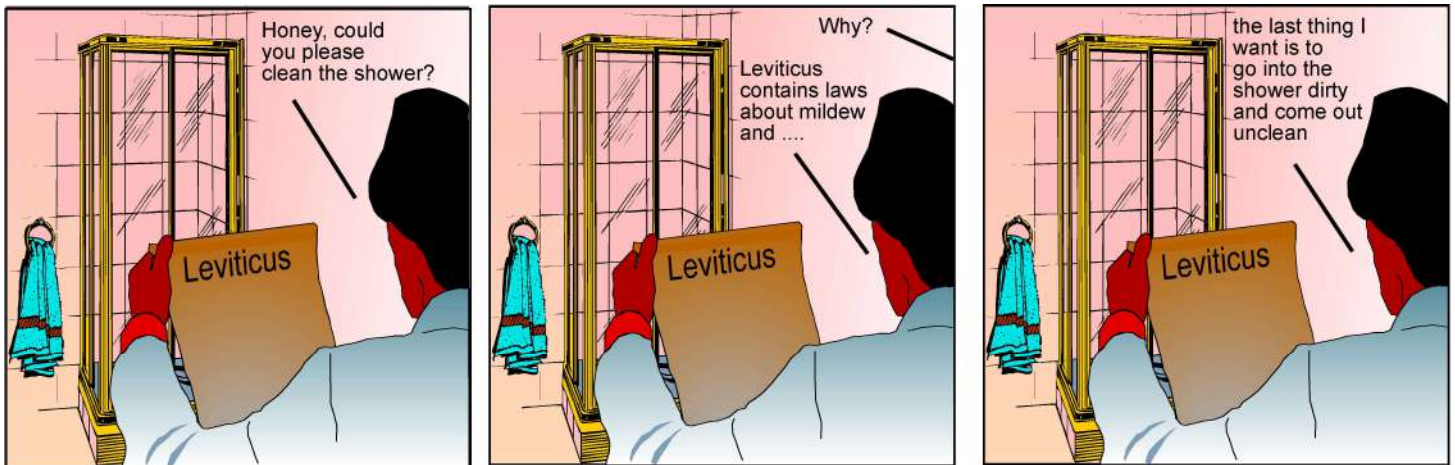


Leviticus
