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Fun Bible Facts What were clothes made of?

Clothing in ancient Israel was usually woolen fabric, either dyed or in its natural color, or linen, made from a plant called flax.

Women were largely responsible for production of clothing in all stages of manufacture. They shared responsibility for tending the animals in the flock. Spun the wool into lengths of fabric, using portable looms, grew and harvested flax for linen.

When the flax had been harvested they dried the flax and spun the flax into either fine or coarse linen strips.

Prepared dyes of various colors: blue from wood, yellow from pomegranate, lilac from myrtle, etc. Even the poorest Jewish women used vegetable dyes to get a range of colors for the family's woolen clothes. Flax did not take dye well.
